In addition, Steganos Safe now offers Dropbox encryption in real time. This means that any changes to the local safe file are automatically synchronized with the safe file in the Dropbox cloud. This real-time encryption ensures that even the cloud provider cannot access the data during upload, since it is encrypted by Steganos Safe before being uploaded.
